The **PATH (Park action toward health)** project was started as a result of the survey carried out among residents, showing a path between Starbold Court and the Longdon Road entrance as a high priority desire.

The pathway will have distances marked out on it so you keen exercisers will know how far you have jogged/walked, as well as more equipment alongside to supplement your regime (or perhaps even start one?).

To raise this money, we are launching '**Be a Brick - Adopt a Brick**' in January 2006. As members we can offer you the chance to be first in the queue.

These, high quality, engineering bricks will be individually engraved with black lettering with the message of your choice. They will be a long lasting legacy and a way to remember your bond to Knowle.

Your named bricks will be laid as an edging to the path as it is laid, so it is a **one off** chance, up to the end of March 2006. In addition we will highlight the names of all contributors on the Friends of Knowle Park website as well as within the AGM minutes.
